Seeking JavaScript GEEKS!

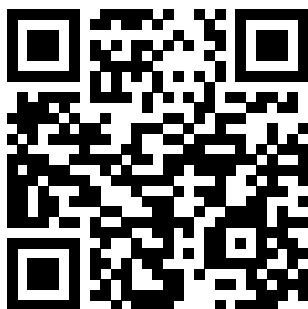
The SEMS group at the **Department of Systems Biology and Bioinformatics** aims at improving the management of computational models. To boost our studies we seek motivated students to extend our team.
